



CAPA Dublin Center

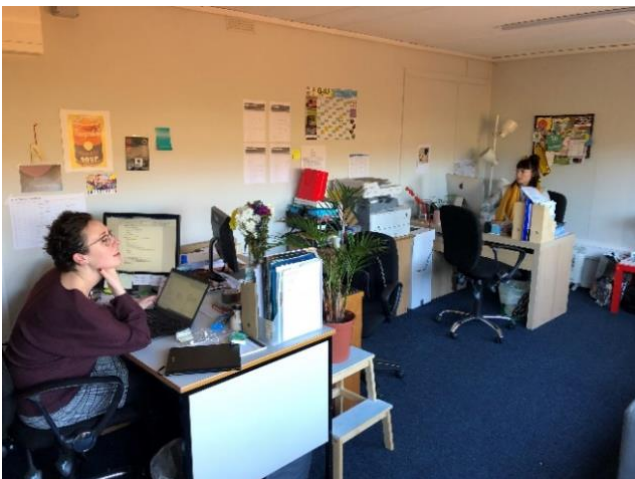
The CAPA Dublin Center is located in Ireland's largest private College, Griffith College Dublin. The CAPA Dublin Center is just a 25-minute walk from the city center, and there are public transport links just outside the campus which will take you all over the city—so you're within easy reach of most areas of the city, and the airport.

We're surrounded by quiet residential neighborhoods, shops, cafes, and restaurants, plus we're almost next door to the beautiful Grand Canal—a lovely spot to go for a stroll! Getting into the city from the airport is easy—there's a choice of both bus and train services, as well as plentiful taxis which are relatively inexpensive.

CAPA Dublin has been on [Griffith's campus](#) since 2012, and we have a great working relationship with the Griffith College staff. There are two CAPA offices on campus: our Resident Director's office and the Student Services office.





Although there will be other students in study abroad programs and the Erasmus program also studying at Griffith College, CAPA is the only study abroad provider based on campus. We have an open-door policy, meaning you can pop into us with any questions you may have during the semester.

The Griffith College Dublin campus buildings date back over 200 years to their construction in 1813. During the past two centuries, they have regularly played a part in both local and national political events. Since its purchase by Griffith College in 1991, we have sought to combine the rich history of the buildings that surround us with the academic objectives of the College. The site has seen significant investment with student accommodation and a conference center complementing the original buildings.

There are around 4,500 students enrolled at Griffith College each semester, and there are over 80 nationalities on campus. Although Griffith College may seem like a smaller campus than you might be used to, it has plenty of facilities similar to those at your home institution! The Students' Union organizes fantastic [day and weekend trips](#), and they have plenty of clubs and societies to keep you busy during the semester. There is also a restaurant on campus where you can enjoy breakfast, lunch, and dinner.



Griffith College also has a library, computer labs, printing services, a fitness room, and the Main Reception. The on-campus student accommodation houses up to 650 students, and there is also free Wi-Fi throughout the campus.
