WHAT IS SYDNEY LIKE?

Sydney is currently home to over five million citizens, commonly referred to as Sydneysiders. Sydney's story is one of both prosperity and controversy. Indigenous Australians have occupied the Sydney area for over 30,000 years, and it remains one of the richest in Australia in terms of native Aboriginal archaeological sites, with an abundance of engravings located throughout the city.

Over the last two and a half centuries, Sydney has modernized and morphed into one of the most fascinating cities in the world, showing off its many charms in the form of cultural diversity and collections of beautiful natural and urban landscapes. It is home to a wide set of globally recognized people and landmarks. Many of the individual cultures that make up the Sydney mosaic are centered on the cultural, artistic, ethnic, linguistic, and religious communities formed by waves of immigration from over 180 nationalities. Much of what you will see and experience will depend entirely on your curiosity and skills to explore this wonderful land!





WHERE WILL I BE IN SYDNEY?

The CAPA Sydney Center is in the heart of the city of Sydney. From the CAPA Center, you will be in very close proximity to some of Sydney's busiest streets, districts, and landmarks. Depending on your experiences with big-city living, you will, without a doubt, find Sydney a very interesting place to navigate, as you will witness the delicate combination of its rambunctious and orderly nature.

The CAPA Sydney Center is located on Level 5, Block B, Building 5 at UTS Haymarket. Your orientation and classes will take place here.

The lovely CAPA Sydney staff will also be here to help you and chat with you. The Center has six classrooms, a study area, and a student lounge you can use. Office hours are between 8:30am and 5pm on weekdays, but you will have access to the Student Lounge from 8am-8pm every day of the week. Students often use this space to study or hang out before, between, or after classes. If you prefer to study in other spaces, you can always chat with your local CAPA staff member as they will be able to point out some fantastic study spaces in the city.









HISTORY OF THE CAPA SYDNEY CENTER

The CAPA Sydney Center was previously located at TAFE Ultimo, but since May 2022 has found a new home at the University of Technology Sydney, one of the world's leading young universities (under 50 years old) and ranked in the Top 150 universities in the world. This historical building, located at the Haymarket precinct, was once a market building with its landmark bell tower and was home to the UTS Library and Faculty of Law before their relocation to UTS Central.

The CAPA Center is split across two levels; the ground level features three lecture-style classrooms and a communal lounge, kitchen, and courtyard, while Level 5 hosts two more classrooms, CAPA staff offices, the student lounge, the study area, a faculty lounge, and a meeting space.
