Irish institutions use different terms when discussing departments, majors, courses, etc. These will be important to know when reviewing the academic options on the program. Below is a brief glossary:

Students pre-register for modules before the semester starts and officially register once on campus.

CAPA recommend securing academic approval of 8-10 courses prior to departing for the program. Students should take no more than 30 ECTS credits (15 US credits), which is 5 modules.

Students can select courses from three different faculties: **Arts, Celtic Studies & Philosophy**; **Social Sciences**; and **Science & Engineering**.
