Irish institutions use different terms when discussing departments, majors, courses, etc. These will be important to know when reviewing the academic options on the program. Below is a brief glossary:

United States	Ireland
Department	Faculty
Course/Class	Module

Students pre-register for modules before the semester starts and officially register once on campus.

CAPA recommend securing academic approval of 8-10 courses prior to departing for the program. Students should take no more than 30 ECTS credits (15 US credits), which is 5 modules.

VIEWING FACULTY AND MODULES

Students can select courses from three different faculties: Arts, Celtic Studies & Philosophy; Social Sciences; and Science & Engineering.

After selecting a subject within one of those faculties, students can view the available modules.

Take note of the number of credits, and in which semester the module is offered.

Clicking on the module name provides an overview of the module, learning outcomes, assessment information, and more.
