

University College Dublin Academic Website Guide

Students will register for modules (what we call courses in the US) around a month prior to the start of the program. Module information will be sent to you directly from UCD.

CAPA recommend securing academic approval of 8-10 courses prior to departing for the program. It is recommended that students take between four and six modules.

Use the filtering systems to search by subject or module level. It is recommended to search modules by school, as you will likely be taking all of your modules within one department.

Module registrations take place in three phases:

- 1. Register student account (2-4 weeks prior to program start)
- 2. Register for modules within a department (1-2 weeks prior)
- 3. Register for modules outside of the department (in-country) via the study abroad program manager within their department
