CAPA will register for courses on the student's behalf. It is important to note that it is very unlikely students will be able to enroll in all their preferred courses, so CAPA recommends securing academic approval of 8-10 courses. Students will submit their course preferences to CAPA directly.

SEMESTER COURSES

Semester students are eligible to take classes across UPF's programs: **Barcelona Program for Interdisciplinary Students (BaPIS)** and **ESCI-UPF International Business Program**. Students are also eligible to take regular university courses with concentrations in basic biomedical sciences, information and communication technologies, and Spanish language courses.

Students should take no more than four courses.
